What is ClickView?

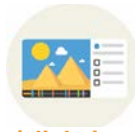
ClickView is a suite of thousands of interactive videos and related resources that support learning and teaching across all subject areas. Videos are professionally made in Melbourne studios or sourced from free-to-air and pay-TV content.

Log in via eduPass at www.edustar.vic.edu.au/clickview

- Teachers log in using their employee number and password
- Students log in using their eduPass details
- Schools with existing ClickView subscriptions will continue to log in as normal at www.clickview.com.au but can move across to the eduPass log in at the expiry of their current subscription term

- Edit, annotate, upload and share videos and resources
- Explore different learning modes, including flipped classrooms
- Access an advertisement-free pay-TV and free-to-air recording and storage service
- Set videos for students to view in their own time, allowing more time for inquiry based learning
- Deliver individualised learning activities to students and view and assess their responses

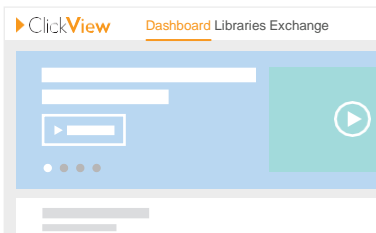
Log in to ClickView

- 1 Log in via eduPass at www.edustar.vic.edu.au/clickview using your employee number (teachers) and eduPass credentials (students). Schools with existing ClickView subscriptions will continue to log in as normal at www.clickview.com.au but can move across to the eduPass log in at the expiry of their current subscription term.



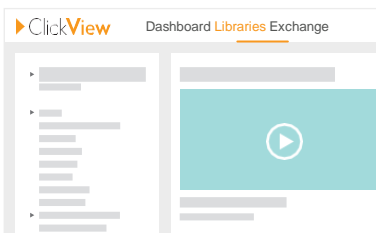
- 2 **See the latest and most popular videos, and use the Albert search function on the Dashboard to find videos**

View all featured videos in one convenient location, or use Albert to find the perfect video for your classroom by searching via curriculum codes or learning areas.



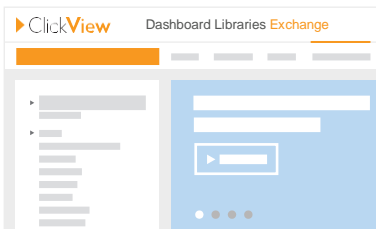
- 3 **Browse and search titles in Libraries**

Within Libraries, you can find the videos in categories on the left side of the page or by typing keywords into the search bar.



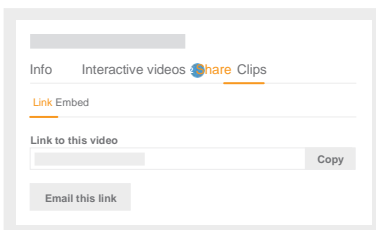
- 4 **Find current TV programs tailored to learning needs**

Use ClickView TV to find ad-free TV recordings from 18 free-to-air channels. Find the best educational TV programs uploaded by teachers on the ClickView Exchange.



- 5 **Share videos with your students**

Once you have found a video you want to share, click on the Share tab, then copy and paste either the Link or Embed in your school's LMS or website.



- 6 **Create an interactive video**

Simply find a video you want to edit and click the Create link directly under the video to modify or add content.
